“Single-vineyard durif from the Kalleske vineyard in the Western Barossa; a mix of new (25%) and seasoned American oak hogsheads. Deep, deep colour in the glass hints at the horsepower within. Full bodied and opulent with plush blackberry and black cherry fruits, abundant spice, a whiff of coconut and super dense fine tannins and a long, powerful finish flush with cassis, kirsch and grilled figs. It’s no wallflower.”

“I read someone complaining recently about a wine that they’d been served in a restaurant, that had an alcohol reading of 11%. “What a ripoff!” they said, seriously. This Buckboard Durif from the Barossa would be better value on their scale, I suspect. This is a very solid release. It’s a wine of deep colour, good texture and lots of sweet fruit flavour. It tastes of sweet plums and cedar sawdust, cloves and blueberries, and while it’s relatively simple it’s also satisfying.”
